Main Duties & Responsibilities:

- Lead guests in a safe and fun manner through our challenge course, which includes a zip line, giant swing, high ropes courses, climbing tower for people ages 5 and older.
- Demonstrate the ability to build trust, confidence and good communication
- Lead corporate, school and other groups in team building activities designed to improve communication, leadership, trust, teamwork, and problem-solving.
- Lead social groups to enjoy our adventure center via parties and other fun events.
- Communicate with guests and staff in a professional and friendly manner that instills trust, support and creates lasting memories
- Assess the safety functionality of all adventure equipment prior to use. Makes sure that adventure course
 is clean of trash, safe and in good working order
- Act as a positive ambassador whenever asked about the company and its service offerings
