**Job Overview**

Camp Counselors will actively participate in all aspects of camp life! Working alongside a Program Lead, Camp Counselors will help create memorable experiences for campers ages 5-17 at our high adventure camp. Camp Counselors must be available from June 13th through August 26th. During this time, Camp Counselors must be available to start the day at 8:00 am and expect to finish at 5:00 pm. Please understand that due to the nature of our programming that shift end times may be variable. Additionally, they must be available for training from June 13th through 17th.

**Responsibilities and Duties**

Camp Counselors will:

- Make camp a fun experience for campers by planning and preparing activities
- Lead arts and crafts, environmental education, games, hiking, rainy day, and other activities for ages 5-17
- Make camp a safe experience by monitoring camper behavior and adhering to all safety policies in place by Terrapin Adventures
- Help provide a supportive and welcoming space for campers and staff of varying backgrounds and abilities
- Monitor camper behavior during all activities to ensure a safe, kind, and harmonious environment for all staff and campers.
- Engage with campers at all times when on duty
- Provide support on our aerial adventure course by assisting in the operation of our zip line, climbing tower, and high ropes course.
- Help campers resolve conflict
- Assist in the daily preparation and clean up of activities and program spaces
- Encourage campers to try new activities, while respecting their boundaries
- Lead overnight programming for campers as needed throughout the summer

**Qualifications**

- Must be at least 18 years of age OR 17 and graduated from high school
- Must hold an active First Aid and CPR certification during the summer
- A federal, state, and child protective services background check must be passed prior to working with campers. Additionally, Camp Counselors must undergo the fingerprinting process.
- Past experience working with children, a plus.
